Eitan Levine is known for his rapid-fire humor, deeply observant storytelling, and distinct comedic voice—qualities that have earned him a national following and a steady presence across major media platforms. Often described as a "writer and

comedian/human theme park," Levine's work spans television, print, digital media, and viral social content.

Levine's on-screen credits include *Jimmy Kimmel LIVE*, *Late Night with Stephen Colbert*, *The Daily Show*, *Extra*, *Access Hollywood*, and *The Kelly Clarkson Show*. As a writer, he has contributed to *The New York Times*, *New York Magazine* (*The Cut*), Amazon, Sony, and *Reader's Digest*, and has collaborated on creative campaigns for brands including Nike, Red Bull, JEEP, Audible, and TruTV.

With more than 150,000 followers across social media platforms, Levine has carved out a niche as a creator of fast-paced, culturally attuned digital comedy. His "Jewish Man on the Street" series—especially the breakout segment "Jewish or Antisemitic"—has garnered more than 28 million views, solidifying his place as a resonant and relevant comedic voice for a new generation.

Audiences and community members are invited to arrive early to visit the Student Art Festival galleries, open from 12-5 PM, and then as a special pre-show moment, participate in a Pop-Up Chanukah presented by Rabbi Josh Franklin, Cantor Debra Stein, Rabbi, and Jewish Center of the Hamptons at 5 PM in Guild Hall's Boots Lamb Education Center.
